

The technical process

The customer must update the file format and implement the new Message Implementation Guide (MIG). Key changes and explanation are described below.

When sending a payment file (Pain.001) to Nordea the file must include a unique identifier for the person (Approver) that have authorized the payments in the customers own system. The unique identifier will be validated towards the approvers registered in Nordea's internal systems before payments are processed.

The Approver identifier should be a Social Security number (SSN) for persons in Nordic countries and provided in the file with code SOSE. For payment approvers outside Nordic countries a passport number or a national ID-card number should be used, provided in the file with code NIDN.

It is very important that the ID number used in the payment file exactly matches the ID number registered on the Approver in New Admin database. See [Appendix A - The administrative process](#).

Additionally, an authorization reference XARF should be created and included in the file, and one XARF ID per Approver is required. XARF is created by the customer based on their own specification/internal processes. XARF is mandatory to include but not validated by Nordea. Consider this as your own internal reference.

When the updated MIG is implemented, we would like you to do a "penny test". This means sending a file containing a small payment to one of your own accounts, or a small non critical vendor payment. This allows you to verify that the changes are fully operational.
